The organization:



- Conducts motivational seminars at shelters, prisons and halfway houses;
- Conducts spiritual seminars for churches, and Christian groups;
- Sends movies, tapes and books to those in areas hit by natural disasters and those serving in the armed forces overseas;
- Works with hospital chaplains to provide resources for patients (through hospital libraries and otherwise);
- Works with high school guidance counselors to recruit and train students to go into assisted living and skilled nursing facilities to visit, read to the residents, play games with the residents and just cheer them;
- Sends volunteer workers to disaster areas, such as the Gulf Coast, to help rebuild.

Continue on US-23/US-441 - go 32.4 mi. Bear right onto the US-23 N/US-441 N/US-441-BYP N/US-64 E ramp - go 0.4 mi. Bear right at US-23 N/US-441 N/US-441-BYP N - go 5.7 mi. Continue on US-23/US-441 - go 2.3 mi. Continue on US-23 N/US-441 N - go 11.8 mi. Take the US-23 N/US-74 E ramp to Waynesville/Asheville - go 22.7 mi. Take the NC-209/US-23-BR exit 104 to East Waynesville/Lake Junaluska/Hot Springs - go 0.1 mi. Turn left at US-23-BR - go 0.3 mi. Continue on Crabtree Rd - go 0.1 mi. Turn left at Access Rd/County Rd - go 165 ft. Continue on Lake Junaluska Depot Rd - go 407 ft. Turn right at Lakeshore Dr - go 0.2 mi. Bear left at Pinson Trl - go 428 ft. Turn right at Lambuth Dr - go 0.1 mi. Turn right at Atkins Loop - go 0.2 mi. Arrive at 49 Atkins Loop, Lake Junaluska, NC 28745
